Tyler's Tune



I am coming up on finishing my first year of my Master's Degree program, and I'd like to share one of the topics we've covered to encourage you as we gather in worship this morning.

Let's be honest. Some Sundays, the songs come easy. Our hearts are full, our voices are strong, and worship feels natural. But other Sundays? We show up tired, distracted, or carrying something heavy. Maybe we feel distant from God, or life just feels overwhelming. And on those days, singing can feel like the last thing we want to do.

So why sing when we don't feel like it? Because worship is not about how we feel. It's about **who God is**.

We sing because *He is still worthy*, even when our emotions are running low. We sing to remind our hearts of what's true. Psalm 42:5 says, "Why, my soul, are you downcast? ... Put your hope in God, for I will yet praise him." Worship is not pretending everything is fine. It is lifting our eyes above what we see and feel and choosing to trust God in the middle of it.

Sometimes, the most meaningful worship comes in a whisper. It's that quiet lyric sung through tears, or the decision to stand and sing when we would rather sit in silence. That kind of worship is powerful because it comes from a place of faith.

So if today is one of those heavy days for you, you're not alone. You don't have to pretend. Just bring your heart honestly before God. Sing the truth until your soul remembers it. God is close to the brokenhearted. And even if your voice is shaky, your worship still reaches His heart.

Keep singing. He's listening.
