I came across this article about this beloved hymn and wanted to pass it along. As we dwell on the words let us sing out in worship to Jesus Christ and all He did At Calvary!

“At Calvary” by Thy Hymns

The opening words to the hymn “At Calvary” become more meaningful as the story behind the hymn is understood. So, let’s find out first his personal testimony, in order for us to understand why he wrote this and what was his inspiration in writing the words of this hymn.

AUTHOR’S PERSONAL TESTIMONY:

William R. Newell, born on May 22, 1868, in Savannah, Ohio, had a troubled youth marked by rebellion. His father, desperate for help, wrote to Dr. Torrey, the president of the Moody Bible Institute, seeking assistance for his wayward son. Initially, Dr. Torrey declined, as the institute was not a reform school. However, after persistent pleas, Dr. Torrey agreed to help under the condition that the young man would visit him daily and adhere to the institute’s rules.

To everyone’s surprise, the rebellious teen, William, faithfully met with Dr. Torrey each day. Through their interactions and guidance rooted in God’s word, William’s spiritual questions were answered, and he eventually professed his faith in Christ as his personal Lord and Savior. This transformation led William R. Newell to become a minister, and he later returned to Moody Bible Institute as a teacher.

HYMN STORY:

In 1895, William wrote a poem describing his testimony, originally on the back of a used envelope. He then visited the Music Director at Moody Institute, Daniel Towner, who composed a joyful and celebratory tune for the poem. Unlike most hymns about Christ’s suffering, which are reflective and somber, this hymn takes a different approach, celebrating Christ’s accomplishment at Calvary with a melody and harmony that exude joy and celebration.
